What is LAMP?

LAMP is a regional recruitment and retention alliance committed to promoting careers in Library and Information Science (LIS).

How does it work?

LAMP utilizes a multifaceted approach, which includes institutional collaboration, summer institutes and internships, professional and peer mentoring, and financial support to promote studies in LIS. LAMP activities emphasize:

- Creating a regional support network of LIS faculty, professionals, and students to guide and encourage prospective students during the process of exploration and subsequent pursuance of an LIS degree
- Recruiting promising undergraduate students to participate in events designed to increase their awareness of career opportunities
- Providing financial support for LAMP scholars to participate in activities and to pursue an LIS degree
- Encouraging participation of students from statistically and historically underrepresented populations
